Provisional students are defined below: 1) A continuing graduate student whose cumulative grade point average at the close of any term is less than a 3.0. 2) A beginning graduate student who does not have an overall 3.0 grade point average of 2.5 3) A beginning graduate student who has qualified for admission by taking nine graded graduate credits as a undeclared student. A student admitted provisionally must complete the first three courses totaling at least eight credits of graduate work, with an average of at least a 3.0. A provisional student w
